

**HEALTHCARE PROVIDER ORDERS FOR STUDENTS
WITH OR WITHOUT PUMP Form #200 and #201
Instructions**

Purpose:

The Healthcare Provider Orders is a document that is required for medication/treatment administration at school. The form is used for the healthcare provider to prescribe a particular medication/treatment for school. It also provides a way for parents to consent to administration of medication and/or treatment. This form documents the ability level of the student in managing their diabetes and/or needed involvement of school staff as determined by healthcare provider and parent.

Instructions:

- The form needs to address medication/treatment for the entire school year.
- If medication/treatment changes during the school year, a new form should be completed by parent and healthcare provider.
- The healthcare provider and parent will determine the ability level of the student in managing their diabetes.
- This form will assist the school nurse in developing the individualized health plan.

Documentation:

- This form should be kept in the clinic in either the medication book or with the original individualized health plan.
- The form should be filled out completely with signatures of both the healthcare provider and parent.
