# Health information is in your hands

MyChart gives you direct online access to portions of your electronic medical record (EMR) where your healthcare provider stores your health information.

### With MyChart, Children's Hospital Colorado patients and families can:

#### View medical information online

- See medications, immunizations, allergies and medical history
- · See test results

#### Communicate with your healthcare team

- · Send and receive secure messages with your healthcare team
- · Request renewals of medications online
- Request appointments
- · View past and future appointment details

## Sign up online or on your smart phone for FREE!

Your provider or office staff can help you enroll. This can be done prior to, during, or after your visit. You will receive a letter with your access code and instructions on how to activate MyChart. You must access MyChart before the expiration date noted in your letter.

Sign on at home at mychart.childrenscolorado.org or at MyChart kiosks. Download the MyChart app free in the iPhone app store or Andriod market by searching "MyChart." Select Children's Hospital Colorado from the list to register with your iPhone or Android.

### Important note: access to a child's chart will vary depending on the child's age

Under the age of 14: parents/guardians will have full access to all aspects of the child's MyChart, including appointments, medications, test results, and more.

Ages 14 –18: parents/guardians will have limited access. They will have the ability to message the child's provider(s), but they will no longer be able to view test results, appointments, etc. The 14 – 18 year old child will have full access to their MyChart.

18 years or older: parents/quardians will no longer have any access to the child's MyChart, while the child over 18 years of age will have full access to their MyChart.

Special needs: If a child is 14 years of age or older, with special needs, and unable to manage their own healthcare, a special allowance will be made allowing parents/guardians to maintain full access to all aspects of the child's MyChart. Please talk this over with your child's healthcare team.
